Starting numbers

Starting numbers will be handed out from the [registration tent at the start and finish area](#)* by showing your registration confirmation which comes via email right after registration

Course inspection

On Saturday, the 14th April 2018, athletes can take a free bus trip to [inspect the course](#). Every passenger receive a wine sampling glass filled with a local "Pfälzer" wine. The busses will be leaving from "Haus der Deutschen Weinstrasse" in Bockenheim at 2.00 pm, 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm.

Noodle-Party

Each runner gets a voucher for the noodle party on collecting the race documents.

Shuttle-Bus / parking

All the parking areas in Bockenheim will be sign-posted. The number of parking spaces is limited so we do advise you to use the free [Shuttle-bus service](#)*. This service will be running on race-day from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm and all the [pick-up points](#)* will be signposted.

Duo-Marathon

A special train (departure 9.53 am) transports the runners from the railway station Bockenheim to Bad Dürkheim. The start number is the ticket. The change zone is at the refreshment point at km 20. The return from the railway station Bad Dürkheim will be at 11:45 am, 0:45 pm and 1:45 pm. More informations see [here](#).

Changing rooms and showers

Showers and changing rooms are located in the local schools in the [area of the start and finish zone](#)* next to the festival area.

Refreshment

[11 refreshment points](#)* are at km 5,5 / 9,5 / 13,5 / 20 / 23 / 27,5 / 31 / 33 / 37 / 39 and 42,2.

Runners can also hand over their own individual drinks/refreshments which will be then transported to the required refreshment point. All drinks must be marked with the runners start number and the number of the refreshment point and handed over to the info point in the festival tent before 8:30 am on the race-day.

Toilet

Toilet facilities are available at the "[Festplatz](#)" in [Bockenheim](#)* as also in the changing rooms. Further more mobile toilet units will be posted close to the refreshment points.

Luggage delivery

Clothes can be delivered in the registration tent. They must be picked up until 4:30 pm again. However the organizers neither will nor accept responsibility for lost or stolen things.

Withdrawing Competitors

If you are unable to finish the race and decide to withdraw, transport by the DRK will be provided from all refreshment points.

Health / massage

Medical staff from the German Red Cross (DRK) will be present at each refreshment point and also at the Finish area. Participants must immediately stop competing when ordered to do so by the doctor in charge or an official member of the medical team (the German Red Cross). Further more a massage tent will be positioned in the Finish area.

Award Ceremony

The prize giving ceremony for women and men's categories (places 1 - 3 and special categories) will take place for the Half Marathon at around 1:00 pm and for the Marathon and Duo-Marathon at about 3:30 pm on the stage in the festival tent. Age category winners (places 1 - 3) can collect their prizes in the festival tent after the ceremony (2:00 pm halfmarathon, 4:00 pm marathon). It will not be possible to send these prizes by post.

Result List and Certificates

Photo Service

A competitor photo service will be provided by "go4it-foto" and photos will be taken from various points of the race and at the finish. These digital photos can be viewed and ordered under [www.go4it-foto.de](#).

Time measurement

A [transponder](#) on the start number measures the time. The start number must be worn clearly visible and must not be bent.
